

Lyons Public Library is a member of Chemeketa Cooperative Regional Library Service (CCRLS) which includes 18 libraries in Marion, Polk and Yamhill counties and a small area in Linn County.

At lyons.ccrls.org or ccrls.org you can:

- **Look up** materials from all 18 member libraries
- **Request** items to be sent to the Lyons Library for convenience
- **Check** your account, renew items and update personal information
- **Opt-in** to your Reading History and keep track of your reading
- **Pay** fees with a credit card
- **Access** databases on a variety of topics
- **Get** notification of holds and other information via e-mail
- **Download** audio books, videos and E-books via Library2Go

Library card options:



FREE for residents in the Lyons city limits, and cities in Polk, Yamhill, and Marion counties and a small area in Linn county, with a member library. **Lyons residents pay for library operations at a much higher rate than non-residents.** Those who do not live in a city with a library in these counties have these options:

1. **Basic card:** no charge, restricted to 10 items and 10 holds.
2. **Kid's C.A..R.E. card:** free for children under 18. Allows 25 check-outs on children's and young adult materials.
3. **Full service fee card:** \$60 per year per household. Accepted at all CCRLS libraries.
4. **Taxpayer card:** people who own property in Lyons can get a free full service card

Residents of other counties in Oregon

1. **Out of CCRLS district card:** \$70 per year for a full service card
2. **Oregon Library Passport Card:** Free for those with cards from participating libraries. List on www.LibrariesofOregon.org. Restrictions apply.

Checkout periods

Books, CDs, audio books: 2 weeks, 3 renewals.

DVDs and magazines: 2 weeks, 3 renewals.

Lyons Public Library offers:

- Books, e-books, DVDs, CD audiobooks, music CDs, magazines and more!
- Free Wi-Fi access during library hours.
- Free internet and word processing on our 6 public computers.
- Cultural passes to the Oregon Garden, Gilbert House Children's Museum, and the Santiam Family YMCA Stayton Pool
- Community information and announcements.

- Storytimes for children: Wednesdays at 10:00am (Sept-May)
- Summer programs featuring performers, events and more.

Just a few rules:



- Library loan privileges require returning materials on time and in good repair. We allow for normal wear and tear.
- Parents are responsible for their minor children's fees and fines.
- We reserve the right to suspend library privileges if an account is misused and for misuse of the internet service.

Fines:

- \$.25 per day for materials, except for DVDs and videos which are \$1 per day.
- Use of the card is blocked automatically if more than \$10 is owed. Excessive charges may be sent to a collection agency after 90 days.
- If we have your e-mail, we will send a courtesy notice before items are due.
- Items can be returned and fines can be paid at any CCRLS member library.
